(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 12) ORDER 2022
KITSON HILL ROAD, LEE GREEN AND OLD BANK ROAD, MIRFIELD**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

In response to road traffic collisions and road user injuries occurring at the Water Royd Lane-Old Bank Road crossroads junction with Lee Green and Kitson Hill Road in Mirfield (locally known as 'Saville Arms Crossroads'), a collision prevention scheme is being proposed. Most of the collisions have involved vehicles emerging from the side roads – Lee Green or Kitson Hill Road – coming into conflict with others travelling along the priority through route – Water Royd Lane-Old Bank Road.

So, to help maintain clear visibility splays to from the side junctions, it is proposed to introduce 15 metres of 'No Waiting At Any Time/No Loading At Any Time' on the remaining arms not covered by the relocated zebra crossings' zigzags with the intention of improving road safety here.

It also proposed to extend the current 'No Waiting At Any Time' parking restrictions on Kitson Hill Road for a distance of 4 metres from the junction of Water Royd Lane to try to maintain access to and from a private drive.
