KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 16) ORDER 2022 HALIFAX ROAD [A649], HARTSHEAD MOOR, CLECKHEATON

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects a length of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

1. Introduce a mandatory no U-turn restriction in both directions on A649 Halifax Road, Hartshead Moor, Cleckheaton from a point 50 north-west of the extended centre line of Walton Lane for a distance of 175 metres south-eastwards.

N.B. The initial proposals for this Order also included a proposed one-way system on A649 Halifax Road, which will not be implemented.
