TRAFFIC REGULATION (NO. 26) ORDER 2020

Cambridge Road Edgerton Huddersfield

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to

- (i)** prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-
south-east side from its junction with Claremont Street south-westwards to its terminal point; and north-east side from its terminal point for a distance of 21 metres north-eastwards;
- (ii)** to introduce permit holder parking places which will operate at all times on Cambridge Road, Edgerton, Huddersfield from a point 21 metres north-east of its south-western extremity for a distance of 51 metres north-eastwards for persons whose place of residence is in premises, the postal address of which is Belgrave Terrace, Belmont Street, Cambridge Road, Cedar Avenue, Cedar Mount, Clare Hill, Claremont Street, Elmwood Avenue, Elmwood Close, Fitzwilliam Street, Highfields Road, Little Brunswick Street, Mountjoy Road, New North Road, Newhouse Place, Portland Street, Trinity Street (excluding Nos 53-71 inclusive) Vernon Avenue (Nos 1 - 1a, 3 -15 (odds) and 6 - 44 (evens)), Vernon Close, Waverley Road, Wentworth Street (or any other person to whom a permit has been issued for use in that behalf);
- (iii)** to revoke items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Huddersfield area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.
