

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.28) ORDER 2021
NABCROFT LANE AND COLLEGE STREET, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Dewsbury area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Nabcroft Lane, Huddersfield

On both sides from its junction with Blackmoorfoot Road for a distance of 43 metres south eastwards

2. College Street, Huddersfield

On its North-west side from its junction with Nabcroft Lane for a distance of 11 metres in a north-easterly direction

(ii) Revoke an item related to Nabcroft Lane in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HUDDERSFIELD AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

REASON: It is intended these proposals will help reduce congestion for traffic travelling in and out and along Nabcroft Lane and help maintain access into and out of College Street.
