

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 29) ORDER 2021
MILL CARR HILL ROAD, INTERCHANGE WAY AND CLIFF HOLLINS LANE,
OAKENSHAW**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Oakenshaw area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Cliff Hollins Lane, East Bierley, Bradford

On both sides from the Kirklees / Bradford boundary for a distance of 168 metres along the centreline in a south-easterly and north-easterly direction

2. Interchange Way, East Bierley, Bradford

On both sides from the junction of Cliff Hollins Lane for a distance of 80 metres along the centreline

3. Mill Carr Hill Road, Oakenshaw, Bradford

On both sides from its junction with Bradford Road to the Kirklees / Bradford boundary

REASON: It is intended that these proposals will facilitate the free flow of traffic on the roads concerned and improve road safety for all road users including access to the new business park and the nearby school.
