

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 30) ORDER 2020  
SOUTH PARADE CLECKHEATON**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Cleckheaton area in the Kirklees district, will be to introduce school keep clear zones operating Monday to Friday 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4pm on South Parade Cleckheaton on its North-east side from a point 1 metre north-west of the south-east property boundary of 90 South Parade for a distance of 37 metres south-eastwards on the entrance markings.
