

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 34) ORDER 2020
VEHICLE MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS
A638 MARKET STREET & WESTGATE, BLANKET HALL STREET AND
MARKET PLACE CAR PARK, HECKMONDWIKE**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under its powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Heckmondwike area of the Kirklees district, will be to

- I. prohibit U turns in both directions on the following lengths of road:-Market Street, from its junction with High Street to its junction with Blanket Hall Street; **and**
- II. Westgate, from its junction with Blanket Hall Street to its junction with Northgate to create a one-way traffic flow on Blanket Hall Street from its junction with Regent Street to its junction with Market Street in a south easterly and north easterly direction to create a mandatory left turn on the following lengths of road Blanket Hall Street from Blanket Hall Street to Westgate; **and**
- III. Market Place car park from the northern most exit of Market Place Car Park to Market Street to revoke items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No 44) Order 1986 which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

The order takes effect on 1st April 2021

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it, or they, are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act, has not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. by 10th May 2021) apply for the purpose to the High Court quoting reference quoting reference DEV/JE/D116-2034
