(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 34) ORDER 2020

VEHICLE MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS

A638 MARKET STREET & WESTGATE, BLANKET HALL STREET and MARKET PLACE CAR PARK, HECKMONDWIKE

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees (“the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order which relates to various roads in Heckmondwike in the Kirklees district:-

PART I

1. Interpretation

- 1.1. Save where the context requires, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the numbered Article bearing that number in this Order.

PART II

2. One-way traffic flow

- 2.1. Save as provided in Article 2.2 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to such length of road in Column 2 of the said First Schedule.
- 2.2. Nothing in Article 2.1 shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle when being used for that purpose.

PART III

3. Mandatory Left Turns

- 3.1. Save upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer every person causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall cause that vehicle on reaching the road referred to in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Second Schedule to make a left turn into that road

PART IV

4. Prohibited ‘U’ Turn

- 4.1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order to make a ‘U’ turn into the lengths of road specified in Column 2 of the said Third Schedule

PART V

5. Revocations

- 5.1 The orders referred to in Column 1 of the Fourth Schedule are hereby revoked to the extent shown in Column 2 and Column 3 of that Schedule.

PART VI

6. General

- 6.1. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 6.2. Any reference in this Order to a Statute or Statutory Instrument shall include reference to any re-enactment or replacement thereof.
- 6.3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 2021 and may be cited as the "Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No. 34) Order 2020".
