| Queen Street - From a point 112 metres north of its junction with Queensgate to its junction with King Street | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prohibit driving except for loading '6 – 10am and 4 – 8 pm', except for cyclists and authorised vehicles |
| King Street | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prohibit driving except for loading '6 – 10am and 4 – 8 pm', except for cyclists and authorised vehicles |

These changes are intended to improve cyclist and pedestrian connectivity and safety within the town centre and specifically along Cross Church Street and Queen Street.
