

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL (SPEED LIMIT) (NO 105) ORDER 2019
B6118 LILEY LANE, GRANGE MOOR**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects various roads in Grange Moor will be to impose a speed limit of 30 mph on the:-

B6118 Liley Lane	from a point 320 metres north of its junction with A642 Wakefield Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 84 metres north west of its junction with the produced north-western kerbline of Back Lane..

And to impose a 40mph speed limit on:

B6118 Bog Green Lane/Upper Heaton Lane/Moor Top Road/Highgate Lane/Bellstring Lane/Liley Lane	from a point 73 metres east of its junction with the produced eastern kerbline of Dalton Bank Road to a point 84 metres north west of its junction with the produced north-western kerbline of Back Lane.

If the order takes effect it will revoke:

KMC Speed Limit (no.26) order 2000 :Item relating to
First Schedule item no. 6 – B6118 Liley Lane, Grange Moor and
Second Schedule item no. 3 - B6118 Bog Green Lane/Upper Heaton Lane/Moor
Top Road/Highgate Lane/Bellstring Lane/Liley Lane

Reason:

Improvements are proposed to Liley Lane to provide a new access with improved visibility along the site frontage of a new development.

Relocation of the existing speed limit is intended to increase awareness and reduce vehicle speeds as they approach the new junction. In the interests of improved safety for all road users by a reduction of vehicle speeds prior to the junction
