

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 107) ORDER 2021
HELEN'S GATE, ALMONDBURY (20mph speed limit)**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects roads in the Almondbury in the Kirklees district, will be to impose a 20 mph speed limit on the whole length of St Helen's Gate from its junction with Fenay Lane to its junction of Arkenley Lane in a south-easterly, north-easterly, south-easterly and south-westerly direction

REASON:

A planning application has been approved for additional classrooms at King James' School. It is anticipated that the development will result in an increase in pedestrian numbers using St Helen's Gate. To improve road safety for pedestrians, it is proposed to introduce a 20mph speed limit along St Helen's Gate, from the junction of Fenay Lane to the junction of Arkenley Lane. Further it is considered this proposal will improve road safety for all road users
