

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 109) ORDER 2021
HALIFAX ROAD, HUDDERSFIELD
(30MPH SPEED LIMIT)**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects roads in the Huddersfield area in the Kirklees district, will be to:

- Impose a 30mph speed limit on Halifax Road, Huddersfield from a point 85 metres southeast of the junction with Birkby Road north-westwards for a distance of 1,020 metres

REASON:

There are improvements proposed to the A629 Halifax Road which is being supported by the West Yorkshire Combined Authority as part of a wider programme of highway improvement schemes to support economic growth throughout the region.

As part of the improvements to the A629 Halifax Road the speed limit is proposed to be lowered from 40mph to 30mph from a short distance southeast of the Halifax Rd/Birkby Rd junction north westwards to Ainley Top Roundabout.

It is intended the Order will improve road safety for all road users.
