

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.11) (ORDER 2020)
CROSS CHURCH STREET, KING STREET AND QUEEN STREET, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road at Huddersfield in the Kirklees district, will be as follows:-

1. To prohibit the waiting of motor vehicles at any time on:-
 - (i) Cross Church Street, Huddersfield
 - a) Eastern side from its junction with King Street to its junction with Kirkgate; and
 - b) Western side from its junction with King Street southern corner to its junction with Kirkgate
 - (ii) Kirkgate, Huddersfield
 - a) Southern side from its junction with Cross Church Street for a distance of 4 metres in a westerly direction; and
 - b) Southern side from its junction with Cross Church Street for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction
 - (iii) Queen Street, Huddersfield
 - a) Western side from its junction with the un-named access road to Nos 21-23 Princess Alexandra Walk for a distance of 4 metres in a northerly direction; and
 - b) Eastern side from a point 147 metres north of its junction with Queensgate for a distance of 65 metres in a northerly direction; and
 - c) Western side from a point 33 metres north of its junction with the un-named access road to Nos 21-23 Princess Alexandra Walk to its junction with King Street
2. To prohibit the waiting or loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on:-

Queen Street, Huddersfield Eastern side from its junction with Queensgate for a distance of 102 metres in a northerly direction
3. To introduce a disabled bay on:-

Queen Street, Huddersfield on its western side from a point 4 metres north of its junction with the un-named access road to Nos 21-23 Princess Alexandra Walk for a distance of 22 metres in a northerly direction

which will operate at all days and all hours. Waiting will be limited to 3 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.
4. To introduce loading bays which will operate at all days between the hours of 6am-10am and 4pm-8pm for a period no longer than 30 minutes without the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant on:-
 - (i) Cross Church Street, Huddersfield on its western side from a point 22 metres south of its junction with Kirkgate for a distance of 34 metres in a southerly direction
 - (ii) King Street, Huddersfield on its northern side from a point 41 metres east of its junction with Cross Church Street for a distance of 22 metres eastwards and on its southern side from a point 18 metres east of its junction with Queen Street for a distance of 16 metres eastwards
 - (iii) Queen Street, Huddersfield on its eastern side from a point 151 metres north of its junction with Queensgate for a distance of 12 metres in a northerly direction
5. To revoke items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Huddersfield Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 which will be redundant if these proposals take effect.
