

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 13) ORDER 2022
FIELDHOUSE LANE, GREENHEAD ROAD, LUCK LANE AND PARK AVENUE
HUDDERSFIELD AND MOORSIDE ROAD, KIRKHEATON**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield and Kirkheaton areas of the Kirklees district, will be to

(i) prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Fieldhouse Lane, Huddersfield

- a) On its north-west side from its junction with Old Fieldhouse Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a south-westerly direction and then 7 metres south-easterly across end of lane to south-eastern kerb line
- b) On its south-east side from its junction with Old Fieldhouse Lane for a distance of 17 metres in a south-westerly direction

2. Luck Lane, Marsh, Huddersfield

- a) On its north-west side from a point 68 metres south-west of its junction with New Hey Road for a distance of 30 metres in a south-westerly direction
- b) On its south-east side from a point 39 metres south-west of its junction with Westbourne Road to its junction with Shires Fold

3. Moorside Road, Kirkheaton

On its East side from its junction with Heaton Drive for a distance of 33 metres in a south-easterly direction

(ii) to introduce a permit holder parking place on the following lengths of road: -

1. Luck Lane, Marsh, Huddersfield

- a) On its north-west side from a point 8 metres south-west of its junction with New Hey Road for a distance of 60 metres in a south-westerly direction
- b) On its south-east side from a point 22 metres south-west of its junction with Westbourne Road for a distance of 17 metres in a south-westerly direction

These parking places will operate Monday to Saturday between 8.00am to 10.00pm for the use of residents of No. 4 to 22 (even numbers) and 16a Luck Lane

(iii) Prohibit the waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles during the times and days specified on the following lengths of road marked with “School Keep Clear” markings:-

1. Greenhead Road, Huddersfield

On its North-west side from a point 28 metres south-west of its junction with Park Avenue for a distance of 26 metres in a south-westerly direction

Monday to Friday, between 8:00am to 9:30am and 14:30pm to 16:00pm, on entrance markings

(iv) to revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HUDDERSFIELD AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017 and the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No 13) ORDER 2018, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

Please note that the implementation of the proposed prohibition on waiting on lengths of Park Avenue, Springwood (as well as the revocation of existing provisions related to Park Avenue) has been deferred at this time.

This Order was made on 31 January 2023 and will take effect on 10 February 2023.
