

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F
FENAY LANE and ST HELEN'S GATE, ALMONDBURY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Fenay Lane and St Helen's Gate Almondbury.

Feature 1 – Plateaued Puffin Crossing

The centre point of the crossing area is to be 30 metres north-east of the junction with St Helen's Gate, with associated zig zag markings extending 23 metres south westwards and 27 metres north eastwards of the centre of the crossing area.

Feature 2 and 3 - Plateaux

2. Fenay Lane

The centre point of the plateau is to be 30 metres north-east of the St Helen's Gate junction, and to be a total length of 9.5 metres (comprising of 1.5 metre ramps, and a 6.5 metre flat top). The height of the plateau is to be 75mm.

3. St Helen's Gate

The centre point of the plateau is to be 33 metres east of the Fenay Lane junction, and to be a total length of 6.5 metres (comprising of 1.125 metre ramps, and a 4 metre flat top). The height of the plateau is to be 75mm.

REASON: Primarily to assist children walking between King James's School and Almondbury centre and pedestrians crossing St Helen's Gate, following Ward Councillor request on behalf of the school and subsequent assessments, it is proposed to implement a signalled 'puffin' crossing on Fenay Lane. The existing speed plateau on Fenay Lane (currently sited circa 12 metres below the St Helen's Gate junction) will also be moved to the site of the proposed puffin crossing.

It is also proposed to provide a footway strip at the bottom of the steps running between Fenay Lane and St Helen's Gate, and site a raised plateau on St Helen's Gate

Further, it is proposed to erect a mirror on the face of the retaining wall opposite no. 29 St Helen's Gate, as visibility of westbound traffic is compromised by the bend in the road when crossing St Helen's Gate towards the steps
