

KIRKLEES COUNCIL
CLECKHEATON (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 2) ORDER 2021

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in in the Heckmondwike area in the Kirklees district, will be:-

- To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:-

Alfred Street, Heckmondwike on its south-west side from its junction with Kaye Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards; and
Kaye Street Heckmondwike on its north-west side from its junction with Alfred St for a distance of 10 metres north-eastwards and its north-west side from its junction with Alfred St for a distance of 10 metres south-westwards

- To introduce residents parking on Alfred Street on its south-west side from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Kaye Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards for Alfred Street residents and/or any other person to whom a permit has been issued for that purpose
- To revoke parts of Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Cleckheaton Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 which will be redundant if this order takes effect

REASON: vehicles parking up to and on the junction of Kaye Street/Alfred Street, Heckmondwike block access for vehicles delivering to/collecting from the business at the end of Alfred Street and this order proposes to provide 10 metre lengths of 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions on Kaye Lane at each side of the junction, and on the south west side of Alfred Street, and shorten the permit parking bay here accordingly to resolve that issue.

It is considered these proposals will facilitate the free flow of traffic on the roads concerned and improve road safety for all road users.
