

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.21) ORDER 2022  
BLACKMOORFOOT ROAD & MILL STREET, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-**

Blackmoorfoot Road, Huddersfield

- a) On its South-east side, from the south-western kerb-line of Mill Street for a distance of 8 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- b) On its South-east side, from the north-eastern kerb-line of Mill Street for a distance of 11 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Mill Street, Huddersfield

- a) On its North-east side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Blackmoorfoot Road to its junction with Crosland Street
- b) On its North-east side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Crosland Street for a distance of 2 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- c) On its South-west side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Blackmoorfoot Road for a distance of 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.

**(ii) To introduce loading bays which will operate Monday – Saturday from 8am – 6pm on: -**

Blackmoorfoot Road, Huddersfield

On its South-east side, from a point 8 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Mill Street for a distance of 10 metres in a south-westerly direction.

Vehicles may wait for a period not exceeding 30 minutes

**(iii) Revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HUDDERSFIELD AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**

This Order was made on 28 March 2023 and will take effect on 04 April 2023.
