

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 24) ORDER 2022
BUTTERNAB ROAD, WHITEGATE ROAD, THORPE LANE, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Butternab Road, Beaumont Park, Huddersfield

On its North-east side from a point 86 metres south-east of its intersection with the extended eastern kerbline of Butterwood Close for a distance of 124 metres in an easterly and south westerly direction

2. Thorpe Lane, Almondbury, Huddersfield

- a) On its North-west side from the eastern boundary of Nos. 3a/5 Thorpe Lane for a distance of 41 metres in a south-westerly direction
- b) On its South-east side from its junction with Thorpe Grange Gardens for a distance of 14 metres in a south-westerly direction
- c) On its South-east side from its junction with Thorpe Grange Gardens for a distance of 26 metres in a north-easterly direction

3. Whitegate Road, Newsome, Huddersfield

On its South-west side from a point 82 metres south-east of its junction with Newsome Road for a distance of 44 metres in a south-easterly direction

AND

(ii) Revoke provisions in the below Orders, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced:

- Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Huddersfield Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (Schedule 1 Item 605 (d))
- Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No. 03) Order 2021 (Schedule 1 Item 2 (a))

This Order was made on 21 March 2023 and will take effect on 03 April 2023.
