

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 27) ORDER 2022
FIRTH STREET, SHEPLEY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Shepley area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

Firth Street, Shepley, Huddersfield

- a) On its North-east side from a point 12 metres north-west of the north-eastern terminal point of Firth Street for a distance of 18 metres in a south-easterly then south-westerly direction across the terminal end of the road
- b) On its South-west side from the south-eastern terminal point of Flint Street for a distance of 35 metres north westwards including the turning area

This Order was made on 10 January 2023 and will take effect on 20 January 2023.

Any person wishing to challenge the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirements of that, or of any instrument made under it, have not been complied with may apply to the High Court within six weeks following 20 January 2023.
