

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 36) ORDER 2021  
WOODHEAD ROAD, HONLEY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Holmfirth area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**Make a mandatory cycle lane on the following length of road:-**

Woodhead Road, Honley

From a point 178m northwest of its junction with Smithy Place southwest wards to a point 33m southwest of its junction with Smithy Place

**REASON:** To support the planning permission of application no. 2021/62/92206 for Land Off, Woodhead Road, Brockholes, Holmfirth changes to the cycling facilities are proposed.

A new access will be created for the development, of the erection of 137 homes with open space, landscaping and associated infrastructure, on to Woodhead Road (A6024) and there is currently an advisory cycle lane at this access point. This traffic regulation order seeks to make this a Mandatory Cycle Lane across the new access. The existing advisory cycle lane will become a Mandatory Cycle Lane for 211m across the new vehicular access.

It is intended that these proposals will facilitate the free flow of traffic on the road concerned and improve road safety for cyclists.
