

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No.4) ORDER 2021**

**BRADFORD ROAD BATLEY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in Batley in the Kirklees district, will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:- Bradford Road on its north-east side from a point 21 metres north west of the junction of Floreat Close, for a distance of 60 metres south-eastward and on its south-west side from a point 36 metres north west of the junction of Park Drive, for a distance of 50 metres north-westwards.

**REASON:** parked vehicles have obstructed traffic movement past the nearby pedestrian refuge, hindering visibility for drivers entering Bradford Road from Floreat Close. It is considered that the proposals to introduce lengths of 'No Waiting at any Time' restrictions on both sides of Bradford Road will improve road safety and ensure the free flow of traffic.
