

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.4) ORDER 2022
PERMIT PARKING: ODDFELLOWS STREET, BEECH
STREET, SHAW STREET, THE EMBANKMENT, BEECH
GROVE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME: DOCTOR LANE,
ODDFELLOWS STREET. MIRFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Mirfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to

(i) prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Doctor Lane, Mirfield

- a) North-west side from its junction with Nettleton Road for a distance of 9.5 metres south-westwards
- b) North-west side from its junction with Nettleton Road to its junction with Oddfellows Street
- c) North-west side from its junction with Oddfellows Street to its junction with Beech Street
- d) North-west side from its junction with Beech Street to its junction with Beech Grove
- e) North-west side from its junction with Beech Grove to the south-west boundary of No 15 Doctor Lane
- f) South-east side from the boundary of Nos. 10/12 to its south-west junction with The Embankment

2. Oddfellows Street, Mirfield

North-east side from its junction with Doctor Lane for a distance of 41 metres north-westwards

(ii) to introduce a permit holder parking place on the following lengths of road: -

1. Beech Grove, Mirfield

- On both sides from its junction with Doctor Lane North-westwards over its entire length.

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is listed in Appendix 4 of the Order.

2. Beech Street, Mirfield

- On both sides from its junction with Doctor Lane north-westwards over its entire length.

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is listed in Appendix 2 of the Order.

3. Oddfellows Street, Mirfield

- On Both sides from its junction with Doctor Lane north-westwards over its entire length.

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is listed in Appendix 1 of the Order

4. Shaw Street, Mirfield

- On both sides from its junction with Chapel Street North-westwards over its entire length.

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is listed in Appendix 3 of the Order

5. The Embankment, Mirfield

- On both sides from its junction with Doctor Lane South-eastwards, south-westwards and north-eastwards over its entire length.

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is listed in Appendix 5 of the Order

(iii) to revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

This Order was made on 21 March 2023 and will take effect on 31 March 2023.
