

## **Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) 2020**

### **Smithies Moor Rise, Lea Road, Smithies Moor Crescent, The Burrows, The Covert, Birstall**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will, subject to certain exceptions, be to prohibit vehicles with a maximum gross weight of more than 7.5 tonnes from proceeding on any part of the following roads in Birstall :-

Smithies Moor Rise, Lea Road, The Burrows, The Covert; and from the junction of Smithies Moor Crescent to its south western extremity.

Reason: HGVs delivering to and/from businesses on the bottom section of Lea Road have been using the route from Smithies Moor Lane to Lea Road through the residential area to gain access to their premises. The Council considers these changes will improve road safety for all road users and ensure HGVs remain on the classified roads
