

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.7) ORDER 2022  
SERPENTINE ROAD, CLECKHEATON; PROSPECT ROAD, ROBERTTOWN;  
HOLME STREET, LIVERSEEDGE**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Cleckheaton, Roberttown and Liversedge areas of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**(i) prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-**

1. Holme Street, Millbridge, Liversedge

- a) North-east side from a point 69 metres north-west of its junction with Leeds Road for a distance of 20 metres north-westwards
- b) North-west side from its junction with Bradford Road for a distance of 47 metres north-westwards and south-eastwards
- c) South-east side from its junction with Bradford Road for a distance of 3 metres south-westwards
- d) South-east side and north-east from a point 30 metres south-west of the junction of Bradford Road for a distance of 19 metres in a south-westerly and south-easterly direction
- e) South-west side from its junction with Leeds Road for a distance of 25 metres north-westwards

2. Prospect Road, Hartshead, Liversedge

North-west side from its junction with Windy Bank Lane to the boundary of Nos.4/6 Prospect Road

**(ii) prohibit the waiting between Monday – Saturday 8am – 6pm on the following length of road: -**

Serpentine Road, Cleckheaton

North and north-east side from its junction with Northgate to a point 40 metres south-east of the south-eastern boundary of No 40 Serpentine Road

**(iii) to introduce a permit holder parking place on the following lengths of road: -**

Holme Street, Millbridge, Liversedge

- a) North-east side from a point 111 metres north-west of its junction with Leeds Road for a distance of 5 metres north-westwards
- b) South-east side from a point 3 metres south-west of its junction with Bradford Road for a distance of 27 metres south-westwards

These parking places will operate on all days at all hours for the use of persons whose place of residence is Nos. 20-28 Holme Street (evens) and No. 368 Bradford Road

**(iii) to revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**

This Order was made on 10 January 2023 and will take effect on 19 January 2023.
