

KIRKLEES COUNCIL**(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (NO.2) ORDER 2019**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees {hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees) Order 2006 together with all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

Part 1**1. COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION**

This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2019 and may be cited as the Kirklees Council (Off Street Parking Places) (No 2) Order 2019.

Part 2**2. AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ORDERS**

- 2.1 The Orders listed in the Schedule to this Order shall be amended by the insertion of the additional wording detailed in Articles 2.2 and 2.3 of this Order.
- 2.2 Article 17 of the Orders listed in the Schedule to this Order shall be amended by the addition of the following words after the first lettered item (g).
- (h):- an electric vehicle meaning any vehicle which has a plug in electric charge facility
- 2.3 Article 17 of the Orders listed in the Schedule of this Order shall be amended by the addition of the following words after the second lettered item (g):-
- (h) Is actually connected to and using the electric charging point adjacent to the parking bay to recharge the vehicles batteries and is a Hackney Carriage or Private Hire Vehicle when indicated by signage and remains connected to the electric charging point only for the maximum time indicated by signage.
- 2.4 In Column 2 of the Schedule to Kirklees Council (Off Street Parking Places) (No.3) Order 2011 the wording is amended to read "Wholly within the limits of the parking bay"

Statement of Reasons for Making the Order

The Council is introducing some charging points in its car parks to permit free parking for electric vehicles whilst parked charging the vehicle at the charging point. Appropriate signage will indicate which vehicles may use the charging point and any maximum stay applicable.

The Parking Places Order makes the necessary amendments to the existing Orders.

The introduction of electric charging points is part of the Council's Green Strategy and will encourage the use of electric vehicles.

Not all car parks will have charging points but this Order will allow the ongoing "roll out" of charging points in Council car parks.

The Order also corrects a typographical error in the existing Parking Places Order for Greenhead Park car park to ensure that the Order is fit for purpose.
