HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F
Hill Top Estate, Heckmondwike

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Hill Top Estate, Heckmondwike.

Feature 1 – Single round top hump on Hill Top Estate from a point 46 metres generally in a southerly direction of its junction with High Street for a distance of 0.9 metres in a southerly direction.

Feature 2 – Single round top hump on Hill Top Estate from a point 98 metres generally in a southerly direction of its junction with High Street for a distance of 0.9 metres in a southerly direction.

Feature 3 – Single round top hump on Hill Top Estate (eastern side) from a point 202 metres generally in a southerly direction of its junction with High Street for a distance of 0.9 metres in a southerly direction.

Feature 4 – Single round top hump on Hill Top Estate (western side) from a point 177 metres generally in a southerly direction of its junction with High Street for a distance of 0.9 metres in a southerly direction.

These road humps will be 40mm high, have a 900mm long circular profile and will span the carriageway with a 300mm offset from the edge of the carriageway.

REASON: This traffic scheme is proposed following funding being made available via the Heckmondwike Local Members Project Fund, to provide the safety measures within this area. The local ward councillors, based on their experience and knowledge of their wards and concerns expressed by residents, have proposed to use a part of that funding to provide traffic calming within Hill Top Estate.

This scheme is design to tackle the issues of inappropriate speed and anti-social behaviour based around motor vehicles.
