Jackroyd Lane / New Laithe Hill / Fanny Moor Lane, Newsome, Huddersfield

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Jackroyd Lane, New Laithe Hill, and Fanny Moor Lane Newsome, Huddersfield

Speed Cushions;

These will be 75mm high, 3.5 metres long and 1.6 metres wide, with the gaps between each cushion no larger than 1.3 metres in width to suit existing road widths.

Feature 1 – Triple speed cushions on Jackroyd Lane from a point 70 metres south east of the projected south east kerb line of Newsome Road for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 2 – Double speed cushions on Jackroyd Lane from a point 243 metres south east of the projected south east kerb line of Newsome Road for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Road Humps;

These will be round in profile with a maximum height of 75mm, be 3.7 metres long, and will be full width of the carriageway.

Feature 3 – Single round top hump on Jackroyd Lane at a point 26 metres along the centre line of the carriageway from its junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Feature 4 – Single round top hump on New Laithe Hill at a point 82 metres from the junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a northerly direction.

Feature 5 – Single round top hump on New Laithe Hill at a point 177 metres from the junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Feature 6 – Single round top hump on New Laithe Hill at a point 264 metres from the junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 7 – Single round top hump on New Laithe Hill at a point 329 metres from the junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 8 – Single round top hump on New Laithe Hill at a point 398 metres from the junction with High Lane for a distance of 3.7 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 9 – Single round top hump on Fanny Moor Lane from a point 85 metres from the south west kerb line of New Laithe Road for a distance of 3.7 metres in a south-westerly direction.

REASON This scheme is designed to tackle the issues of inappropriate speed, rat running, and anti-social behaviour based around motor vehicles
