

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 27) ORDER 2021
RAILWAY STREET, DEWSBURY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects a length of road in the Dewsbury area of the Kirklees district, is to:

- Prohibit pedestrians from using the south-western footpath alongside Railway Street, Dewsbury from its junction with Rishworth Road for a distance of 37 metres in a south-easterly direction

This Order was made on 01 March 2022 and comes into effect on 07 March 2022.

Any person wishing to challenge the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirements of that, or of any instrument made under it, have not been complied with may apply to the High Court within six weeks following 07 March 2022.
