

Kirklees Council
(Off Street Parking Places) (No.1) Order 2019
Spennorth Fitness Complex car park, Cleckheaton

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce pay and display parking in the existing Princess Mary Sports Centre car park in Cleckheaton. The car park will operate at all times but between 7am and 10pm there will be a requirement to pay for parking. The proposed charges are:-

£2.50 for up to 5 hours;

£4.00 for over 5 hours.

Payment for parking will be available at the ticket machine.

Blue badge holders will be exempt from the charges.

KAL members and visitors will be exempt from the charges but will have to register the vehicle details at reception upon arrival.
