(Off Street Parking Places) (No.1) Order 2019

Statement of Reason of making the Order

The Spenborough Fitness Complex is undergoing construction work over the next two years and some of the existing parking facility is going to be closed. The current free parking facility availability may be compromised so to discourage non users of the Fitness Complex and to ensure that the parking provision is essentially available to KAL members and other users, the Council proposes to introduce parking charges.

Charges will be in effect between 7am and 10pm.

The proposed charges are:-

£2.50 for up to 5 hours

£4.00 for up to 15 hours

KAL members will be able to park for free but will be required to register the vehicle at reception upon arrival.

Blue badge holders will be able to park for free.

It is proposed that this will ensure that the car park will be available to users of the Fitness Complex thus ensuring that the Centre continues to be well used during the period of the essential construction works.

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce pay and display parking in the existing Princess Mary Sports Centre car park in Cleckheaton.

The car park will operate at all times but between 7am and 10pm there will be a requirement to pay for parking. The proposed charges are:-

£2.50 for up to 5 hours;

£4.00 for over 5 hours.

Payment for parking will be available at the ticket machine.

Blue badge holders will be exempt from the charges.

KAL members will be exempt from the charges but will have to register the vehicle details at reception upon arrival.
