

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 11) ORDER 2022  
KNOWL ROAD, MIRFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Mirfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-**

Knowl Road, Mirfield

On its west side from a point 34.5 metres north of its junction with Town Hall Street for a distance of 71 metres northwards and then north-westwards

AND

**(ii) Revoke items related to Knowl Road in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**

**REASON:** To allow the introduction of a zebra crossing on Knowl Road, Mirfield it is necessary to remove the existing limited waiting/permit parking bay outside No 3 - 7 Knowl Road to prevent parking here and ensure minimum visibility distances are maintained on the approach to the proposed zebra crossing for drivers and pedestrians.

As part of these works it is also necessary to extend the current 'No Waiting At Any Time' parking restrictions to extend directly in front of No 7 Knowl Road to join up to the associated lining for the proposed zebra crossing.

It is anticipated these proposals will improve road safety for all road users.
