2. The final submission of nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer, Nomination Room A, High Street Buildings, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield, HD1 2NG from **Monday 16 March 2026 until 4:00pm on Thursday 9 April 2026 (excluding weekends and bank holidays)**.

**Nomination papers will be accepted between the hours of 9:00am and 12:30pm and between 1:30pm and 4:00pm. The close of nominations is 4:00pm on Thursday 9 April 2026 at the above address.**

3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 7 May 2026**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Monday 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online via [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote).
5. Electors and their proxies should take note that any new applications for postal votes or changes to existing postal or postal proxy applications must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, High Street Buildings, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG by **5:00pm on Tuesday 21 April 2026**.
