

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION FOR THE DEWSBURY AND BATLEY CONSTITUENCY

1. An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve in the above Constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained at Electoral Services Office, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Nomination Room A, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG on the following dates and at the times indicated below:

Tuesday 4 June 2024
Wednesday 5 June 2024
Thursday 6 June 2024
Friday 7 June 2024

Nomination papers will be accepted between 10:00am and 4:00pm.
The close of nominations is 4:00pm on Friday 7 June 2024 at the above address.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**.
5. The required deposit of £500 can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom or by bank transfer.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online via www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. New applications to vote by post and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG by **5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. Apply online via www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG by **5:00pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Apply online via www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.
9. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5:00pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/votingphotoid
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3-5 Albion Street, Huddersfield HD1 2NG by **5:00pm on Thursday 4 July 2024**.
