## Kirklees e-panel results - December 2014 survey

In December and January we asked our Kirklees e-panel to take part in a short online survey – we received 448 responses, so around 50% of our e-panellists took part.

We asked them to think about any times they had seen or spoken to our staff face to face, over the phone, in the street, online or at any other time.

## **Summary**

- → 8 out of 10 respondents have had contact with council staff in the last year
- → Questions on staff listening, and caring about helping communities, received the most positive response
- → Results improve when respondents have had contact with council staff in the last 12 months.
