27th Feb—27th March

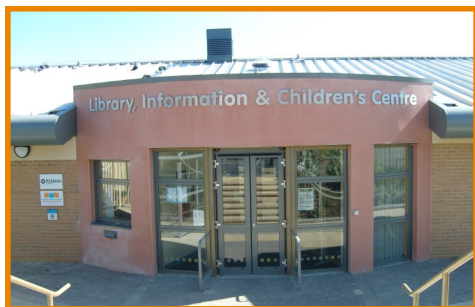
A 5 week programme for parents and children to attend together.
