Designed by Bradford Peace Museum, Safety Online explores the dangers posed by online grooming, hate crime and radicalisation.

Using real life case studies and lasting between 60 and 90 minutes, Safety Online can be tailored for young people, parents and community groups providing participants with an overview of the risks associated with the internet and how they can stay safe online.

Sessions will enable participants to:

- **Understand the techniques used online to spread hate messages**
- **Develop critical thinking skills**
- **Increase their confidence in staying safe online**
- **Give practical guidance on what to do if presented by malicious content**
- **Signpost to further support for those that may need it**
