On 10 September 2021 Kirklees Council confirmed the above order made under section119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that part of public footpath Heckmondwike 20 having a width of 1.5 metres and shown on the plan annexed hereto by a bold solid line commencing at point A at grid reference 2244 2294 and proceeding in an south south-easterly direction for 29 metres to point B at grid reference 2245 2291 then south easterly direction for 30 metres to point C at grid reference 2247 2289 to a new line for public footpath Heckmondwike 20 having a width of 2 metres and shown on the plan annexed hereto by a bold dashed line commencing at point A at grid reference 2244 2294 and proceeding in a southerly direction for 21 metres to point F at grid reference 2241 2292.

The above order will also divert that part of public footpath Heckmondwike 21 having a width of 1.5 metres and shown on the plan annexed hereto by a bold solid line commencing at point D at grid reference 2234 2282 and proceeding in an north north-easterly then east south-easterly direction for 147 metres to point B at grid reference 2245 2291 to a new line for public footpath Heckmondwike 21 having a width of 2 metres and shown on the plan annexed hereto by a bold dashed line commencing at point F at grid reference 2241 2292 and proceeding in a southerly direction for 23 metres to its junction with Laburnum Road at point E at grid reference 2244 2290.

The order came into force as from 10 September 2021, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended or

on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 16 September 2021, make an application to the High court.
