- that part of public footpath Holmfirth 135 shown on the Order Plan by a bold continuous line commencing at point D at grid reference SE 1774 0775 and proceeding in a north north-easterly direction for approximately 10 metres to point B at grid reference SE 1774 0776

to a new line for public footpath Holmfirth 135 with a width of 2 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold broken line commencing at point D at grid reference SE 1774 0775 and proceeding in a west south-westerly then north north-westerly direction via points A at grid reference SE1772 0775 point E at grid reference SE 1772 0775 and point F at grid reference 1769 0783 for 113 metres to point C at grid reference SE 1769 0783.
