PROPOSED DIVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS KIRKBURTON 145 (PART) AND KIRKBURTON 186 (PART) AT FOLLY HALL, CROSS LANE, SHELLEY.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that an application has been received by Kirklees Council to divert parts of public footpaths Kirkburton 145 and 186 at Folly Hall, Cross Lane, Shelley. The application is made under Section 119 of the Highway Act 1980 and is in the interest of the land owner to increase privacy and security.
