

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 – SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14

KIRKLEES COUNCIL (KENMORE DRIVE, KENMORE VIEW, MILTON TERRACE AND ROOKS AVENUE, CLECKHEATON) PUBLIC PATHS STOPPING UP ORDER 2022

The above order was made on the 3rd March 2022. The effect of the Order will be to stop up the following footpaths:

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore Drive at point C at grid reference SE 1832 2574 and proceeding in a straight easterly direction for 120 metres to point B at grid reference SE 1844 2576.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore Drive at point C at grid reference SE 1832 2574 and proceeding in a generally eastern direction for 127 metres to point B at grid reference SE 1844 2576.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore Drive at point C at grid reference SE 1832 2574 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 137 metres to point A at grid reference SE 1839 2586.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore Drive at point C at grid reference SE 1832 2574 and proceeding in an easterly then north easterly direction for 146 metres to point J at grid reference SE 1840 2585.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore View at point D at grid reference SE 1832 2580 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 92 metres to point A at grid reference SE 1839 2586.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore View at point D at grid reference SE 1832 2580 and proceeding in a south easterly direction for 130 metres to point B at grid reference SE 1844 2576.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Kenmore View at point D at grid reference SE 1832 2580 and proceeding in a south easterly direction for 111 metres to point K at grid reference SE 1843 2579.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Rooks Avenue at point A at grid reference SE 1839 2586 and proceeding in a south south-easterly direction for 112 metres to point B at grid reference SE 1844 2576.

A footpath commencing at its junction with Rooks Avenue at point A at grid reference SE 1839 2586 and proceeding in a south south-easterly direction for 110 metres via points J and K to point L at grid reference SE 1843 2577.

Alternative footpaths will be created, namely:

- (1) A public footpath to be known as Spenborough 177 shown on the plan annexed to the Order by the bold dashed line commencing at its junction with Kenmore Drive

at Point C at grid reference SE 1832 2574 and proceeding in an easterly direction along the access road then in a northerly then easterly then south easterly then southerly direction for 226 metres via via points E and F to Point B at grid reference SE 1844 2576; and

- (2) A public footpath to be known as Spenborough 178 shown on the plan annexed to the Order by the bold dashed line commencing at Point E at grid reference SE 1835 2582 and proceeding in a northerly then easterly then southerly direction for 171 metres via points G and H to Point F at grid reference SE 1837 2580 with a branch commencing at point G at grid reference SE 1839 2585 and proceeding in a north westerly direction for 16 metres to point A at grid reference SE 1839 2586 and a short branch commencing at point H at grid reference SE 1840 2585 and proceeding in a north westerly direction for 8 metres to point M at grid reference SE 1839 2585
