PROPOSED DIVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SPENBOROUGH 110 (PART) NEAR FORMER SPEN VALLEY LEISURE CENTRE, BRADFORD ROAD, LIVERSEEDGE.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION APPLICATION – AMENDED APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that an amended application has been received by Kirklees Council to divert part of public footpath Spenborough 110 near former Spen Valley Leisure Centre, Bradford Road, Liversedge.

The application is made under Section 119 of the Highway Act 1980 and is in interest of the landowner.

The length of path to be stopped up is shown by the bold solid line, whilst the path to be created is shown by the bold dashed line, with improvement to width and gradients. The sections of unaffected public footpaths are shown by the continuous line with short bars at intervals.

Please note that this Notice forms part of the preliminary consultation exercise on the applicant's proposal and that no decision on the diversion application has yet been made by the council. An explanatory statement has also been prepared.
