 - Applications for Street Trading Consents, Distribution of Free Printer Matter Licences, Scrap Metal Licences and Sexual Entertainment Licences, require the disclosure of criminal convictions.
- Financial Information

Why we collect and hold this information

We use this personal data in order to:

• Enable us to carry out the Council's duties as the Licensing Authority.

The lawful basis on which we use this information

We collect and process information about you under Article 6(1)(e) in that, the processing of your information is necessary for the licensing service to perform its official lawful functions.

We collect and process 'special category' information under Article 9(2)(g) and 'criminal conviction' information under Article 10, the processing of this information is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest, and that the collecting of this information is proportionate to the aim pursued with that aim being the protection of the public.

Storing this information

We will hold the information about you securely, and for no longer than reasonably necessary.

We will hold it for six years for safeguarding purposes and in case of any legal claims and / or complaints.
