Site reference H2537 Land adjacent to Halifax Road Hightown

Date of Submission: 21st January 2018

Issue: Are the proposed Green Belt release housing allocations in the Batley and Spen subarea justified; effective; developable; deliverable; and consistent with national policy?

Response:

- 1. Spen Valley Civic Society (SVCS) does not think that mitigation measures are required to the northern section of H2537. This small area of green belt is mainly brownfield in the sense that it has been used for many years as a car park on rough ground, for the adjacent restaurant. The remainder is untended scrub.
- 2. However, there is a PROW (113) along the northern boundary, which forms part of the Luddite Trail. Mitigation measures will be needed to ensure this footpath remains open and accessible after housing is developed.
