and Matter 4 question b):

' Does the Plan allocate all known ^{large} potential housing sites within existing built-up areas?'

* ' Is there an opportunity through this inspection * phase for Kirkles Council to further enhance and extend their vision in the The Local Plan by making more affordable housing available in East Bierley in known potential housing sites currently discounted?'
