(Off Street Parking Places) (No.1) Order 2022

Huddersfield Railway Station Car Park

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees have made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the Kirklees Metropolitan Council (Off Street Parking Place) Order 2004 (as amended) by adding some maximum stay of 20 minutes parking spaces in the Huddersfield Railway Station Car Park. NB. There will be no physical changes to the car park as the parking places are the ones directly fronting the Station.

The parking spaces will be free to use but will only be available to rail users.

All other existing restrictions in the car park are unaffected.

The Order was made on 24 May 2022 and will take effect on 27 May 2022.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it, or they, are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act, has not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made apply for the purpose to the High Court.
