KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 8) ORDER 2022 Various Roads in Oakenshaw

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will, subject to certain exceptions, be to prohibit vehicles with a maximum gross weight of more than 7.5 tonnes from proceeding on any part of the following roads in Oakenshaw:-

1. Cliff Hollins Lane

From the north-westerly junction of Interchange Way, Oakenshaw to its junction with Raikes Lane, East Bierley

2. Wyke Lane

From its junction with Bradford Road to the Kirklees / Bradford boundary

3. Greenside

From its junction with Cross Street to the Kirklees / Bradford boundary

4. Cross Street

On its whole length

5. <u>Back Richardson Street</u>

On its whole length

6. Richardson Street

On its whole length

This Order was made on 20 February 2024 and will take effect on 29 February 2024.
